The Exeter Ordination Pathway (EOP)

is a new ordination training pathway being offered by the Diocese of Exeter. It is designed for people identified and called out by their local church leadership with a vocation to serve as an assistant priest in their local context.

Rev'd Dr Mike Harrison, Bishop of Exeter has 'sponsored' Mandy Lewry our Church Parish Manager to be part of this new initiative. As such Mandy, this coming week, will attend a Bishop's Advisory Panel (BAP). The BAP is a residential three-day conference run by the Ministry Division of the Church of England during which candidates are interviewed by three Bishop's Advisers interviews, do a piece of written work, make a presentation and chair a meeting.

The Advisers will then make a recommendation to the Sponsoring Bishop who decides whether a candidate should be offered training for the Ordained Ministry.

We pray for Mandy this coming week, for the other candidates attending the three day conference and for all who are discerning a vocation and ministry.

Have you ever had the feeling that God is calling you? Calling you to use your gifts and skills for his kingdom? Calling you to a new role in the workplace, church or community? Or perhaps He is calling you to licensed or ordained ministry? Do have a conversation with David, the Vicar.

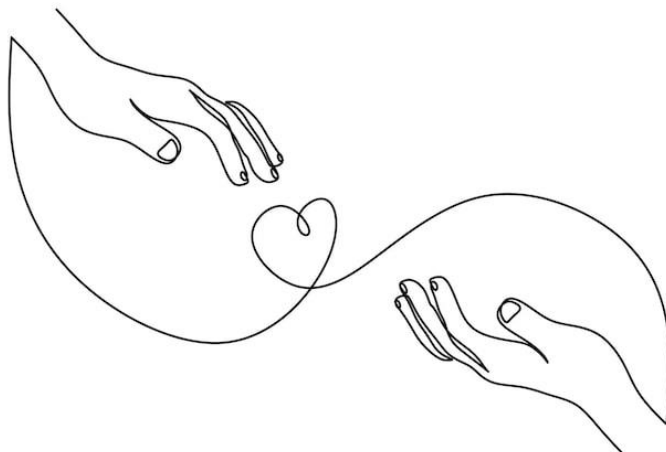
